#### **RULES & REGULATIONS**

#### of the Paignton & District Fanciers' Association To be held at Westpoint, Clyst St Mary, Exeter EX5 1DJ Saturday 6th, Sunday 7th, Monday 8th & Tuesday 9th August 2016 OPEN TO ALL

Vicious dogs are not eligible and must not be brought to the show

Exhibitors are held responsible for any damage done by their dog during the exhibition

- 1 Opening of Show: The Show will open at 7.00 am each day.
- 2 Arrival of Dogs: Dogs will be received until 12 noon and after which no dogs may be received except under very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances and by any special permission of the Show Management.
- 3 Judging Time: Judging will commence 9.30 am each day, unless otherwise stated.
- 4 Show Closes: Exhibits may be removed from the show after their judging has been completed. Exhibits may not be removed any earlier unless by written order of the Veterinary Surgeon, Veterinary Practitioner or of the Show Management and then only in very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances which must be reported to the Kennel Club. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed by which time all dogs must be removed.
- 5 Cooking Stoves: The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of tenting and benching areas is forbidden except as authorised by the Show Management.
- 6 Entry Fees: The following entry fees are payable and include VAT: Breeds with Challenge Certificates on offer: £27.00 for the first entry and £5.00 for subsequent entries with the same dog. Breeds without Challenge Certificates on offer, AVNSC, Imported Register and NFC: £16.00 for the first entry and £5.00 for subsequent entries with the same dog. Champion and Veteran Stakes: £27.00 if the dog is not entered in breed classes. YKC £16.00 if the dog is not entered in breed classes, and J/AHA entries £5.00. (NB: J/AHA entries MUST be made by the closing date). After paper entries close entry fees will be £28.00 and £17.00 for 1st entries. YKC Handling £5.00. Caravans: one week £70; £12 per day extra days, hook-up £40. Car Parking Free. Catalogues £6.00 ordered with entries, £7 on the day. Group catalogues £5.00 (prepaid only). You may enter online at www.dog.biz. ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED ONCE AN ENTRY HAS BEEN MADE.
- 7 Prize Money: Prize money, where paid, is detailed under the relevant Stakes Classes.
- 8 Refusal of Entries: The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
- 9 **Puppies:** Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
- 10 Mating of Bitches: The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
- 11 Best Puppy in Show. From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information). (Definition: Shows judged on Group System refer to Regulation 27B).

Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and is unbeaten by any other puppy exhibited at the same show. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the show. Where the Best of Breed, Best of Group or Best in Show is a puppy it should automatically be awarded Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Similarly if the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best of Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it should also automatically be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed, Best of Group and Best in Show respectively.

- (a) Championship Shows Judged on the Group System
  - (1) Best Puppy in Breed. A Best Puppy must be declared in each breed from puppies entered in the breed classes.
  - (2) Best Puppy in Group. From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information).

Best Puppy in Group and subsequent puppy group placings must be selected from:

- (a) Those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed provided that they are unbeaten by any other puppy.
- (b) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each Group or on each day provided it is unbeaten by any other puppy.
- (3) Best Puppy in Show. From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information). Best Puppy in Show must be selected from the Best Puppy in Group winners provided they are unbeaten

Best Puppy in Show must be selected from the Best Puppy in Group winners provided they are unbeaten by any other puppy.

(b) Withdrawal from Other Competition. Puppies which become eligible for Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition, other than Breed classes and Best Puppy in Breed, prior to the competition for Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A puppy beaten in competition for Best Puppy in Group or Best Puppy in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dog declared Best Puppy in Show however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Puppies may be withdrawn from Any Variety classes when judged before Breed classes.

- (c) **Proviso.** For the purposes of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to one breed, will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
- 12 Best in Show. From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information). The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and is unbeaten by any other dog exhibited at the same Show.

Definition of a Category 3 Breed. A breed from time to time designated by the General Committee as requiring particular monitoring by reason of visible condition(s) which may cause health or welfare concerns. The list of designated Category 3 Breeds is kept under regular review.

#### (a) Shows Judged on the Group System

(Definition: Shows judged on the Group system include classes for breeds within more than one Group, as defined in Kennel Club Regulation B(A); and requires a judge to declare a Best of each Group after which the exhibits so declared will compete for the award of Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show).

(1) Best of Breed. Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared but only from those exhibits which have received a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be declared.

NOTE: The Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified award relevant to a Category 3 Breed will not be confirmed until the dog has passed an examination by the General and Group Championship Show Veterinary Surgeon.

(2) Best of Group. From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information).

Best of Group and subsequent Group placings must be selected from:

- (a) The Best of Breed winners in each Group provided that they are unbeaten winning dogs.
- (b) The best unbeaten winning dog from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each Group or on each day.

NOTE: The dog declared Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified from a breed designated by the Kennel Club as a Category 3 Breed is not eligible to compete in the Group competition unless it has passed an examination by the Show's Veterinary Surgeon. If the dog fails to pass the examination it is ineligible to compete in the relevant Group.

(3) Best in Show. From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information).

Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners provided they are unbeaten. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection of Best in Show.

- (b) Withdrawal from Other Competition. Dogs which become eligible for Best of Group and Best in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition (other than Breed Classes and Best of Breed) prior to the competition for Best of Group or Best in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A dog beaten in competition for Best of Group or Best in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Dogs may be withdrawn from Any Variety Classes when judged before Breed Classes.
- (c) **Proviso.** For the purposes of this Regulation dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to a single breed, will not be considered to be beaten dogs.
- 13 Admission to Groups: Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
- 14 Harsh Handling: Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
- 15 **Preparation for Exhibition:** All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F Annexe B Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition. A special place will be provided for the preparation etc of exhibits and no other place within the precincts of the Show must be used for such purpose.
- 16 Dogs Resident Outside the UK: All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor.
- 17 Dogs in Vehcles on Hot Days: Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at Kennel Club licensed events.
  - When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.

- If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
- The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
- Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
- . When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
- Keep the dog in the shade take your own shade, for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of
  water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
- Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths
  of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK, FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.

- 18 Not For Competition. Not for competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.
- 19 **Schedule Amendments:** No modifications will be made to this Schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
- 20 Regulations: The Show will be held under Kennel Club Limited Rules and Show Regulations. All Rules, Definitions or Instructions of the nature of Rules & Regulations printed for convenience in other parts of this Schedule shall be deemed to be Regulations of the Show and shall have the same effect as if they formed part of these Regulations.
- 21 Receipt of Entries: If an acknowledgement of receipt of entries is required, an addressed stamped card with "Receipt" written on the reverse side should be enclosed. If a VAT receipt is required, please put "VAT Receipt".
- 22 Returned Cheques: Unsigned cheques may result in return of entry and cheques dishonoured by the Bank for any reason will render the exhibitor liable for expenses incurred.
- 23 Benching of Dogs: All dogs must be brought with a suitable strong chain and collar properly fastened on the dog. Dogs of the same breed will be benched together (including dogs entered NFC). Entries for dogs on a day for which their breed is not scheduled cannot be accepted. No decorations, pictures, cards or notices may be placed over the benches except Prize Cards. No bench numbers may be changed from one pen to another and no dog shall be benched on any but its own numbered pen. Under no circumstances may partitions between the dogs be removed.
- 24 Exclusion of Dogs: The Show Management reserve the right to exclude or remove any dog which in their opinion or in the opinion of a Veterinary Officer is not suitable for exhibition.
- 25 Safety of Dogs: The Committee will be most anxious for the care and safety of dogs brought for exhibition but it must be understood by exhibitors and all other persons that the Committee will not be responsible for the entire or partial loss or detention or damage to a dog or dogs, boxes, cages, trolleys, collars or any other property whatever arising from any accident, or any other cause whatever, nor for any act or omission of themselves, their Officers, agents or servants and it is on this understanding only that entries are received.
- 26 Passes: One free pass will be sent for each dog entered but a partnership entering one dog only will be sent two passes.
- 27 Catalogues: Separate catalogues will be available for each exhibitor at a cost of £6.00 (Group catalogues £5.00) and MUST be ordered with entries. Catalogues on the day £7. Each catalogue will contain the owner's name and address (unless otherwise instructed by the owner) in each breed in alphabetical order and the dogs' names in numerical order.
- 28 First, Second and Third Day Winners: First, second and third day winners in the Groups and Stakes classes may be given £20 to defray expenses if they return to compete in the finals on the fourth day. Except where otherwise stated.
- 29 Gangways: Gangways in the tents and between the rings MUST allow free passage at all times and boxes, tables etc. causing obstruction may be removed by the Show Management.
- 30 **Order of Judging:** A provisional Order of Judging will be published in the Canine Press in advance but this is subject to change by the Show Management.
- 31 **Photography and Video Rights:** The Organisers would like to bring the regulation on photography and filming to the attention of exhibitors, trade stands, press and visitors.

It is a condition of all those attending the event that no filming or other form of recording may be taken or made at the venue without express written permission of the organisers. The taking of photographs in the show venue for sale or reward is strictly prohibited except with the written permission of the Organisers. Press accredited photographers are provided with permission to take photographs ONLY for use in newspapers, magazines and internet sites – this is for news purposes only. There is no objection to the general public taking photographs of general views of the show, provided that these are for private use. Specific dogs may be photographed only with the approval of the exhibitor. No photography or filming is permitted in breed judging rings whilst judging is actually taking place. However, judges may allow it to happen at the end of classes or after the Challenge Certificate is awarded. Filming and flash photography is allowed from outside the rings at all times unless the operation of the camera is actually affecting exhibits. However, if a powerful flash unit is used or it is clear that exhibits are being affected, a ring steward or the judge is empowered to stop the person concerned.

- 32 Catering: A full range of catering will be offered throughout the day.
- 33 Coaches: Coaches may be parked free of charge but must remain in the allocated area.
- 34 Fouling: Special stewards will be available to assist in clearing fouling but it remains the exhibitor's responsibility to clear any fouling which occurs.
- 35 **Control of Dogs:** Exhibitors should remember that the Show is on farming land and must NOT allow dogs loose in the vicinity of cattle or sheep which may be in adjoining fields.

## **REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F(B)**

- 1 These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A42.
  - (a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.
  - (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A42.
- 2 (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the Show.
  - (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
- 3 No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:
  - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee.
  - (b) The removal of dewclaws of any breed.
  - (c) Operations to prevent breeding, provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.

Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.

- 4 The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
- 5 An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
- 6 Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

Please note that in the event of a cheque being returned for any reason by the exhibitor's bank or that of his/her agent a surcharge of £10, to cover administration and bank charges, will be levied against the exhibitor. Any exhibitor failing to pay entry fees and/or surcharges so incurred will be referred to the Kennel Club.

#### CHEQUES SHOULD BE MADE PAYABLE TO PAIGNTON & DISTRICT FANCIERS ASSOCIATION WITH THE EXHIBITOR'S NAME (PARTICULARLY IF DIFFERENT FROM THAT ON THE CHEQUE) AND BREED(S) ENTERED WRITTEN ON THE REVERSE.

# **DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES**

(Vide Kennel Club Regulations for Definitions of Classes)

PUPPIES UNDER SIX CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE SHOW ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR EXHIBITION N.B.—The word "dog" includes both sexes

- 1 In the following Definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club.
- 2 Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows.
- 3 In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society.
- 4 In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. 7th June 2016.
- 5 Wins in Variety Classes do not count for entry in Breed Classes, but when entering for Variety Classes, wins in both Breed and Variety Classes must be counted. A First Prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value.
- 6 A dog is not eligible for entry in Variety Classes unless also entered and subsequently exhibited in a Breed Class where such a class is provided for which it is eligible. Exemptions from this Regulation are:

From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class have been suspended.

- (1) A Puppy, unless a class for dogs under twelve months of age for which it is eligible is provided for the breed.
- (2) A dog in Any Variety Field Trial Class.
- (3) A dog in Any Variety Veteran Class.
- (4) A dog in Any Variety Champion Class.
- (5) A dog which is withdrawn from exhibition in breed classes as a result of the appointment of an emergency judge.
- (6) A dog in YKC Stakes Classes.
- (7) A dog in KC Good Citizen Scheme classes.
- (8) Exhibits bred by the scheduled Judge.
- 7 If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:
  - Withdrawal

The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations 9(j) and 20. *Transfer* 

- (a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- (b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy Class, Puppy Class or Junior Class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy Class, Junior Class or Yearling Class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling Class, to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- (c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- 8 If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

MINOR PUPPY—For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

PUPPY—For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

JUNIOR—For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

YEARLING—For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty-four calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

BEGINNERS—For owner, handler or exhibit not having won a First Prize at an Open or Championship Show.

- **NOVICE**—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more First Prizes at an Open or Championship Show (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).
- **UNDERGRADUATE**—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more First Prizes at Championship Shows, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).
- **GRADUATE**—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.
- **POST GRADUATE**—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.
- LIMIT—For dogs which have not become Show Champions under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club or won seven or more First Prizes in all, at Championship Shows

in Limit or Open Classes, confined to the Breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the Breed.

**OPEN**—For all dogs of the breeds for which a class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

VETERAN—For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

- **CHAMPION STAKES**—For dogs which have been confirmed a Champion, Show Champion or Field Trial Champion. Champion Classes may not be scheduled for individual breeds or varieties of breeds.
- **SPECIAL OPEN**—Similar to Open except that it is restricted to the eligibility.
- SPECIAL BREEDERS—For dogs bred by the exhibitor. Exhibits declared Best of Breed who are entered in this class and are subsequently beaten will NOT be disqualified from competing for Best in Group/Best in Show.
- **IMPORTED REGISTER**—For Breeds confined to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by the Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class only, and are ineligible for any other competition whatsoever.
- YKC STAKES—All pedigree dogs are eligible to take part provided the dog is registered on the Kennel Club breed register. The dog must be registered a) solely or jointly in the member's name or b) in the name of a member of the family and under these circumstances the dog must be resident at the YKC member's address. No substitute handlers are permitted the dog must be handled by the YKC member. Members are not permitted to allow another individual to show their dog on their behalf if they are not able to attend the class. Members must be aged 6 24 years (for members 6 years and up to, but not including 25th birthday). Please note that membership of the YKC terminates on a member's 25th birthday. Please note that the YKC diffice will only accept wins from classes that are listed on the YKC website. If a show schedules a YKC class which has not been approved by the YKC Management Team and published on the website, it will not qualify for Crufts. Please note that in order to enter any YKC Crufts qualifying competition you must be a fully paid up member at the time of entry. If you enter a Crufts qualifier and you have not previously paid your membership fee then any award will not count towards qualification for Crufts. Therefore it is important to renew and maintain YKC membership as current if you wish to participate in qualifying Crufts competitions. Crufts 2017 Qualification Procedure: The first placed member only in each dog group at the qualifying show will qualify for Crufts. A rosette and prize money is awarded. If the first placed member has already qualified, the Crufts qualification will roll down to the next member (down to 3rd place only).
- YKC HANDLING CLASSES—Only dogs of six (6) calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for entry into a YKC qualifying class. The Kennel Club has announced with immediate effect, a suspension to the regulation that stipulates dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before being entered in a Young Kennel Club (YKC) Handling Class. The FIRST placed handler only in each age group at the qualifying show will qualify for Crufts. A rosette is awarded to the first place winner. This is not a roll down competition. Handling qualifiers run from the 1st January to the 31st December for the following year's Crufts. If a member is disqualified, the qualification does not roll down to the next placing. Classes for handling are decided by the handler's age. The classes are divided into three age groups: 6-11 years (6 years and up to, but not including 12th birthday). 12-16 years (12 years and up to, but not including 25th birthday). In order to enter any YKC competition, you must be a fully paid up membership fee then any award will be forfeited. Therefore it is important to renew and maintain YKC membership as current if you wish to participate in YKC competitions.
