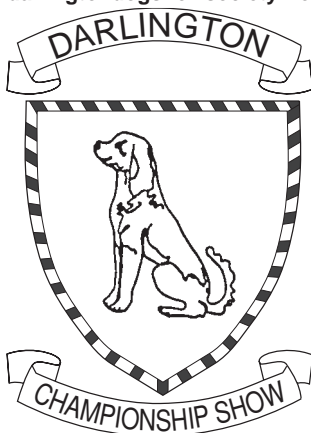

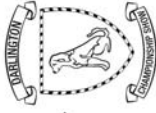
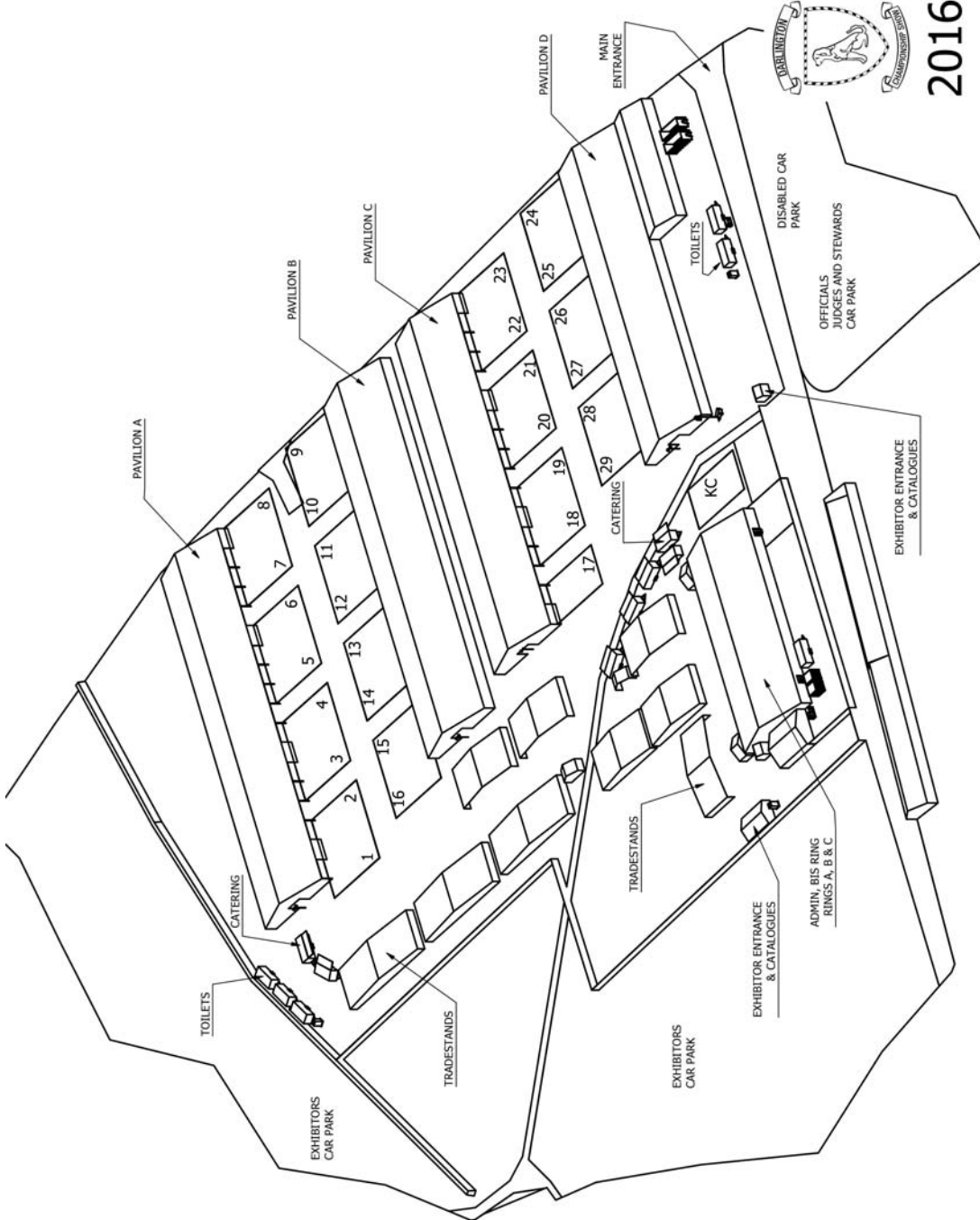

**PHOTOGRAPHY & VIDEO RIGHTS**

The Organisers would like to bring the regulation on photography and filming to the attention of exhibitors, trade stands, press and visitors. It is a condition of all those attending the event that no filming or other form of recording may be taken or made at the venue without express written permission of the Organisers. The taking of photographs in the show venue for sale or reward is strictly prohibited except with the written permission of the Organisers. Press accredited photographers are provided with permission to take photographs ONLY for use in newspapers, magazines and internet sites – this is for news purposes only. There is no objection to the general public taking photographs of general views of the show, provided that these are for private use. Specific dogs may be photographed only with the approval of the exhibitor. No photography or filming is permitted in breed judging rings whilst judging is actually taking place. However, judges may allow it to happen at the end of classes or after the Challenge Certificate is awarded. Filming and flash photography is allowed from outside the ring at all times unless the operation of the camera is actually affecting exhibits. However, if a powerful flash unit is used or it is clear that exhibits are being affected, a ring steward or the judge is empowered to stop the person concerned.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1 The Show will open at 7.30 a.m.
- 2 Dogs will be received at any time but it is the Exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
- 3 Judging will commence at 9.30 a.m. each day. Retriever (Labrador) will commence at 9.00am. The start of judging will not be delayed except in very exceptional circumstances.
- 4 (a) Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed.  
(b) Exhibits may not be removed any earlier unless by written order of the Veterinary Surgeon, Veterinary Practitioner or of the Show Management and then only in very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances which must be reported to the Kennel Club.  
(c) The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed by which time dogs must be removed.
- 5 The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of tenting and benching areas is forbidden except as authorised by the Show Management.

### 6 ENTRY FEES:

**First Class per dog** (in Breed Classes WITH CHALLENGE CERTIFICATES ON OFFER at this Show) will be £26.00 (after noon on 26 July: £28).

**First Class per dog** (in Breed Classes WITHOUT CHALLENGE CERTIFICATES ON OFFER at this Show) will be £15.00 (after noon on 26 July: £17).

**First Class per dog** (entered in a STAKES CLASS ONLY) will be £15.00 (after noon on 26 July: £17).

**All subsequent entries** will be £5.00 per class.

**NOT FOR COMPETITION** entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered. Dogs may be entered Not For Competition on any day of the show (and a bench will be provided) for £12.00 per day. There is **NO PROVISION FOR UNENTERED DOGS** at this Show.

**Admission** to the show is free. **Exhibitors Car Park Prepaid Pass** is £4 payable only with entries. (£5.00 on show day). Spectators cars £10.00.

### **ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED ONCE AN ENTRY HAS BEEN RECEIVED BY THE PRINTER.**

ENTRIES will not be accepted unless accompanied by the appropriate remittance. If acknowledgement of entries is required an addressed stamped card with receipt written on the reverse side should be enclosed with entries for the Official receipt. Evidence must be given of despatch by 19th July 2016.

**CHEQUES OR PAYMENT BY CREDIT CARD** sent to cover entry fees must be in order for immediate payment, otherwise entries will NOT be accepted and will be returned. Bank or administration charges incurred by returned or re-presented cheques will be charged to the exhibitor at £20.00 per transaction. Payment may also be made by credit card. **The Authorisation Security Code (last 3 digits on the back of the card) must be included to validate the card.** Any card number which is not immediately accepted will also be subject to an additional charge of £20.00. Alterations to entry forms to be rectified by the printer, whether on paper or online will incur an administration fee of £5. Entries may be made online at [www.dog.biz](http://www.dog.biz) until **12 noon on Tuesday 2 August 2016. Entry online from Tuesday 26 July 2016 (noon) to Tuesday 2 August 2016 (noon) will incur a surcharge of £2.**

- 7 **PRIZE MONEY.** The amount of prize money on offer at this show is £3,293 in Stakes Classes only.
- 8 The committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
- 9 Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the show are not eligible for exhibition, ie born on or after 17th March 2015. In cases where entries are made for dogs which are not eligible for competition, before the entry fee is refunded, AN ADMINISTRATION CHARGE OF £5 WILL BE DEDUCTED.
- 10 The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
- 11 **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW. From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information).**

Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and is unbeaten by any other puppy exhibited at the same show. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the show. Where the Best of Breed, Best of Group or Best in Show is a puppy it should automatically be awarded Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Similarly if the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best of Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it should also automatically be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed, Best of Group and Best in Show respectively.

### (a) **Championship Shows Judged on the Group System**

(Definition: Shows judged on the Group System – refer to Regulation 27.b.)

(1) **Best Puppy in Breed.** A Best Puppy must be declared in each breed from puppies entered in the breed classes.

(2) **Best Puppy in Group. From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information).**

Best Puppy in Group and subsequent puppy group placings must be selected from:

- (a) Those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed provided that they are unbeaten by any other puppy.
- (b) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each Group or on each day provided it is unbeaten by any other puppy.
- (3) **Best Puppy in Show. From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before**

**exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information).**

Best Puppy in Show must be selected from the Best Puppy in Group winners provided they are unbeaten by any other puppy.

- (b) **Withdrawal from Other Competition.** Puppies which become eligible for Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition, other than Breed classes and Best Puppy in Breed, prior to the competition for Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A puppy beaten in competition for Best Puppy in Group or Best Puppy in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dog declared Best Puppy in Show however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Puppies may be withdrawn from Any Variety classes when judged before Breed classes.
- (c) **Proviso.** For the purposes of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to one breed, will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
- 12 **Best in Show. From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information).**

The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and is unbeaten by any other dog exhibited at the same Show.

Definition of a Category 3 Breed. A breed from time to time designated by the General Committee as requiring particular monitoring by reason of visible condition(s) which may cause health or welfare concerns. The list of designated Category 3 Breeds is kept under regular review.

(a) **Shows Judged on the Group System**

(Definition: Shows judged on the Group system include classes for breeds within more than one Group, as defined in Kennel Club Regulation B(A); and requires a judge to declare a Best of each Group after which the exhibits so declared will compete for the award of Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show).

(1) **Best of Breed.** Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared but only from those exhibits which have received a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be declared.

NOTE: The Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified award relevant to a Category 3 Breed will not be confirmed until the dog has passed an examination by the General and Group Championship Show Veterinary Surgeon.

(2) **Best of Group. From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information).**

Best of Group and subsequent Group placings must be selected from:

(a) The Best of Breed winners in each Group provided that they are unbeaten winning dogs.

(b) The best unbeaten winning dog from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each Group or on each day.

NOTE: The dog declared Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified from a breed designated by the Kennel Club as a Category 3 Breed is not eligible to compete in the Group competition unless it has passed an examination by the Show's Veterinary Surgeon. If the dog fails to pass the examination it is ineligible to compete in the relevant Group.

(3) **Best in Show. From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information).**

Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners provided they are unbeaten. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection of Best in Show.

(b) **Withdrawal from Other Competition.** Dogs which become eligible for Best of Group and Best in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition (other than Breed Classes and Best of Breed) prior to the competition for Best of Group or Best in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A dog beaten in competition for Best of Group or Best in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Dogs may be withdrawn from Any Variety Classes when judged before Breed Classes.

(c) **Proviso.** For the purposes of this Regulation dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to a single breed, will not be considered to be beaten dogs.

13 Exhibits will not be admitted to Group or Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.

14 Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.

15 All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B): Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.

16 All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.

- 17 **Dogs in Vehicles on Hot Days:** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at Kennel Club licensed events.
- When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
  - If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
  - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
  - Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
  - When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
  - Keep the dog in the shade — take your own shade, for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
  - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.
- Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.
- WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK, FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.**
- Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Limited Rules and Regulations. **Right to Refuse Entries.** Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulations to refuse any entry.
- 18 **Not For Competition** entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.
- 19 No modifications will be made to this Schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
- 20 **BEST VETERAN IN SHOW** is a Veteran which has competed and is unbeaten by any other Veteran exhibited at the same show.
- Best Veteran in Breed will be selected from all unbeaten veterans from any breed classes provided they are not beaten by any other veteran.
  - Best Veteran In Group will be selected from all Best Veteran in Breed provided they are unbeaten by any other veteran.
  - Best Veteran In Show will be selected from Best Veteran in Group Winners provided they are unbeaten by any other veteran.
- Proviso** For the purpose of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to one breed will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
- NB: Veterans entered in the Bannerdown Benching/AV Veteran Stakes **ONLY** are not eligible to compete for Best Veteran in show. To be eligible to compete for Best Veteran in Show, a veteran must be entered and exhibited in a breed class and win Best Veteran in Breed and Best Veteran in Group.
- 21 Every exhibitor making an entry or entries at or for this Show shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by the Kennel Club Limited Rules and Show Regulations and by these regulations, and it is on this understanding only that entries are accepted.
- 22 **EXHIBITORS PASSES.** Exhibitor's passes for postal entries will be posted out by the printer. All enquiries must be made direct to Higham Press. Passes for online entries will be available to download from your dog.biz account. Each exhibitor will receive a pass for each dog entered which must be presented at the gate on entering the show with your dog. Admission to the show is free. **A pre paid Exhibitors Car Park pass is £4 payable only with entries,** and £5 on the day. Spectator's cars £10 on the day.
- EXHIBITS ONLY ALLOWED.** No animal other than dogs duly entered for the Show will be allowed within the precincts of the Show during its continuance. There is **NO PROVISION FOR UNENTERED DOGS** other than NOT FOR COMPETITION and SPECTATOR dogs. To enter NOT FOR COMPETITION complete an entry form with the full details and send to the printer with a fee of £12. To enter SPECTATOR dogs an entry form/record slip must be completed at the entrance to the show (no bench provided), cost £12 per dog. Dogs must be present on their benches at all times except when being judged or when being prepared for exhibition and/or being exercised. In certain circumstances dogs must be present on their benches at all times if required by the Show Management. **This rule will be relaxed from 3.00pm onwards to enable exhibitors to bring their dogs closer to the Group ring.** Dogs at this time may be housed on any spare benching at the end of Pavilion C. Preparation of exhibits should take place in the special grooming areas provided. Any unauthorised person found untying or removing a dog from its bench during the hours the exhibition is open, without the consent of the Committee or Manager will be reported as a civil offence and will be dealt with by the Police.
- 23 **ADMISSION TO THE SHOW.** The Show will be open to the Public from 7.30 a.m. each day and admission to the show ground is free. Car parking is available at a cost to exhibitors of £4.00 prepaid, £5.00 on the day. Spectator's cars are charged at £10 per car.
- 24 **GANGWAYS.** Gangways must be kept clear at all times and any dog boxes, cages or other obstruction left in gangways will be removed by authorised officials.
- 25 **SAFETY OFFICER.** A Safety Officer will be in attendance throughout the show. Exhibitors and spectators are reminded that just as Darlington Dog Show Society Ltd. has a responsibility to ensure the health and safety of all those attending their event, all those present have a duty and responsibility for their own safety. They are therefore expected to take the greatest care to avoid guy ropes, uneven surfaces and other hazards which are inevitable and integral elements of a dog show. Those bringing and using portable items of equipment such as folding chairs, trolleys, cages and grooming tables also have a responsibility to ensure that their tools, equipment and collapsible furniture are used and erected safely and does not constitute a hazard to others. Exhibitors are also reminded that

they should wear appropriate clothing and footwear for the prevailing conditions on the site. Exhibitors show at their own risk if conditions are not ideal.

- 26 **SAFETY OF DOGS.** The Committee will be most anxious for the care and safety of the dogs brought for exhibition, or any other property entrusted to them, but it must be understood by exhibitors and all other persons that the Committee will not be responsible for the loss, detention of, or damage to any dogs or other property whether arising from accident or from any other cause whatever, or from any act or omission of itself, its officers, agents, servants or others, or damage done by the exhibits to any person or property.  
VICIOUS DOGS are not eligible for competition and must not be entered for the Show. Exhibitors are responsible for any damage done or caused by their dogs during the exhibition.
- 27 **JUDGING OF CLASSES AND BEST IN SHOW.** All reasonable steps will be taken to warn exhibitors of the judging of Variety Classes, Groups and Best in Show, but the Committee cannot be held responsible for absentees from the competitions. The Committee reserve the right to make any alterations or additions due to unforeseen circumstances which will be published in the DOG PRESS if time permits. It remains the exhibitors responsibility to be present in the ring when required. NB: German Spitz (Mittel and Klein) and Poodles (Miniature and Toy) will be measured and Dachshunds (Miniature) will be weighed at this show
- 28 **CANCELLATION OR ABANDONMENT:** Entry fees will not be refunded in any circumstance where any act of God or any other unforeseen reason causes the cancellation or abandonment of the show after entries have closed.

- 30 Should any questions arise, not provided for by these regulations, the Kennel Club to be the final Court of Appeal. All complaints to be made in writing and left at the Secretary's office, together with the Kennel Club objection fee of £35 where appropriate.

**THE ATTENTION OF ALL EXHIBITORS IS DRAWN TO THE KENNEL CLUB REGULATION RE: FOULING, WHICH READS:**

Any owner, handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog(s) at any Kennel Club Licensed Show within the licensed venue and within the environs of that event including car and caravan parks and approaches.

## **REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F (B)**

- 1 These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A42.
    - (a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.
    - (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A42.
  - 2
    - (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the Show.
    - (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
  - 3 No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:
    - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee.
    - (b) The removal of dewclaws of any breed.
    - (c) The shortening of tails of customarily docked breeds but only up to an acceptable age limit, which shall be prescribed from time to time.
    - (d) Operations to prevent breeding, provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.
- Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
- 4 The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
  - 5 An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
  - 6 Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

The attention of exhibitors is drawn to the fact that any advertisement for a coat preparation or shampoo or similar in either Schedule or Catalogue does not imply that the use of such preparation may not contravene Kennel Club Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition F. This also applies to any coat preparation or shampoo or similar on sale at the Show. The attention of exhibitors is directed to the Declaration they are required to sign on the entry form.

### **REGULATION F(1) 30 GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION**

- (a) A dog may be disqualified by the General Committee from any award, whether an objection has been lodged or not, if proved amongst other things to have been:
  - (7) Exhibited in breach of Regulation F (B)



## DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

(The word 'dog' includes both sexes)

### **PUPPIES UNDER SIX CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE SHOW ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR EXHIBITION**

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club.

Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows.

In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials, each partner must, at the time of entry, be a member of the Society.

In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of **Postal** entries shall be counted when entering for any class, i.e. 12 July 2016.

Wins in Variety Classes do not count for entry in Breed Classes but when entering for Variety Classes, wins in both Breed and Variety Classes must be counted. A first prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value.

A dog is not eligible for entry in Variety Classes unless also entered and subsequently exhibited in a Breed Class where such a class is provided for which it is eligible.

Exemptions from this Regulation are:

From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class have been suspended.

(1) A Puppy, unless a class for dogs under twelve months of age for which it is eligible is provided for the breed; (2) A dog in Any Variety Field Trial or Working Trial Class (3) A dog in Any Variety Veteran Class. (4) A dog in Any Variety Champion Class at a Championship or Open Show. (5) A dog which is withdrawn from exhibition in breed classes as a result of the appointment of an emergency judge. (6) A dog in YKC Stakes Classes. (7) A dog in Good Citizen Scheme Classes. (8) Exhibits bred by the scheduled breed Judge.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:

(1) **WITHDRAWAL**

The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations 9(j) and 20.

(2) **TRANSFER**

(a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of their being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.

(b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy Class, Puppy Class or Junior Class, which is over age but under 12 calendar months of age, 18 calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy Class, Junior Class or Yearling Class respectively of the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy Class, Junior Class or Yearling Class respectively to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.

(c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.

(d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

**MINOR PUPPY**—For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. (i.e. born between 16th December 2015 and 16th March 2016 inclusive).

**PUPPY**—For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. (i.e. born between 16th September 2015 and 16th March 2016 inclusive).

**JUNIOR**—For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. (i.e. born between 16th March 2015 and 16th March 2016 inclusive).

**YEARLING**—For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty four calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. (Le. born between 16th September 2014 and 16th September 2015).

**MAIDEN**—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or a First Prize at an Open or Championship Show (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy Classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

**NOVICE**—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more First Prizes at Open and Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy Classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

**UNDERGRADUATE**—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more First Prizes at Championship Shows, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

**GRADUATE**—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open Classes, whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**POST GRADUATE**—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open Classes, whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**MID LIMIT**—For dogs which have not become show champions under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by The Kennel Club or won five or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Mid Limit, Limit or Open Classes, confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**LIMIT**—For dogs which have not become show champions under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by The Kennel Club or won seven or more First Prizes in all, at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes, confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**OPEN**—For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

**VETERAN**—For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show. (i.e. born on or before 16th September 2009). Best Veteran in show will be judged from the Veteran Group winners. The winning dog from the Bannerdown Benching Veteran Stakes class which has only been entered in the AV Veteran Stakes is not eligible to compete for Best Veteran in Show.

**CHAMPION**—For dogs which have been confirmed a Champion, Show Champion or Field Trial Champion. Champion classes may not be scheduled for individual breeds or varieties of breeds.

**BRACE**—For two exhibits (either sex or mixed) of one breed belonging to the same exhibitor, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

**IMPORTED REGISTER**—For breeds confined to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by the Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class only and are ineligible for any other competition whatsoever.

**NOT FOR COMPETITION**—Societies may at their discretion, accept Not For Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed. (Full details of the dog to be given on the entry form, entered in the correct class for the day and marked N.F.C.)

**SPECIAL BEGINNERS**—For owner, handler or exhibit not having won a Challenge Certificate.

**YKC STAKES**—All pedigree dogs are eligible to take part provided the dog is registered on the Kennel Club breed register. The dog must be registered a) solely or jointly in the member's name or b) in the name of a member of the family and under these circumstances the dog must be resident at the YKC member's address. No substitute handlers are permitted — the dog must be handled by the YKC member. Members are not permitted to allow another individual to show their dog on their behalf if they are not able to attend the class. Members must be aged 6 - 24 years (for members 6 years and up to, but not including 25th birthday). Please note that membership of the YKC terminates on a member's 25th birthday. Please note that the YKC office will only accept wins from classes that are listed on the YKC website. If a show schedules a YKC class which has not been approved by the YKC Management Team and published on the website, it will not qualify for Crufts. Please note that in order to enter any YKC Crufts qualifying competition you must be a fully paid up member at the time of entry. If you enter a Crufts qualifier and you have not previously paid your membership fee then any award will not count towards qualification for Crufts. Therefore it is important to renew and maintain YKC membership as current if you wish to participate in qualifying Crufts competitions. **Crufts 2017 Qualification Procedure:** The first placed member only in each dog group at the qualifying show will qualify for Crufts. A rosette and prize money is awarded. If the first placed member has already qualified, the Crufts qualification will roll down to the next member (down to 3rd place only).

**YKC HANDLING CLASSES**—Only dogs of six (6) calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for entry into a YKC qualifying class. The Kennel Club has announced with immediate effect, a suspension to the regulation that stipulates dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before being entered in a Young Kennel Club (YKC) Handling Class. The FIRST placed handler only in each age group at the qualifying show will qualify for Crufts. A rosette is awarded to the first place winner. This is not a roll down competition. Handling qualifiers run from the 1st January to the 31st December for the following year's Crufts. If a member is disqualified, the qualification does not roll down to the next placing. Classes for handling are decided by the handler's age. The classes are divided into three age groups: 6-11 years (6 years and up to, but not including 12th birthday). 12-16 years (12 years and up to, but not including 17th birthday). 17-24 years (17 years and up to, but not including 25th birthday). In order to enter any YKC competition, you must be a fully paid up member at the time of entry and competition. If you enter a Crufts qualifier and you have not previously paid your membership fee then any award will be forfeited. Therefore it is important to renew and maintain YKC membership as current if you wish to participate in YKC competitions.

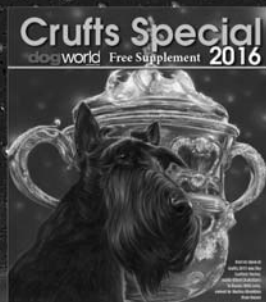
