ABUSIVE BEHAVIOUR

The Society will not tolerate any kind of abusive behaviour to its Officers, Committee or Staff on the Showground or car parks. Anyone found to be behaving in this manner will be asked to leave and a report will be sent to the Kennel Club.

DISABLED DRIVERS

A limited amount of car park space has been allocated for disabled drivers. Access to this area will **only** be permitted to those vehicles displaying an official Disabled Drivers Blue Badge. **The Society do not issue Disabled Car Park Passes.**

FOULING

Any owner, handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove, as soon as possible, any fouling caused by their dog(s) within the licenced venue and within the environs of the event including car parks and approaches. Adequate receptacles for the disposal of such fouling will be provided by the Society.

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR PUPPY IS ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY

(ie over 6 calendar months of age on the FIRST day of the show)
PUPPIES BORN AFTER 2nd MARCH 2016 ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY AT THIS SHOW. THIS INCLUDES DOGS ENTERED 'NOT FOR COMPETITION'
Please note that an administration charge of £5.00 will be deducted before the entry fee is refunded.

DOGS NOT FOR COMPETITION

Dogs may be entered **NOT FOR COMPETITION** and a bench will then be provided. Entry to be made on the entry form in the usual way, **giving full details of each dog.** Please note puppies under 6 months of age are not eligible to enter the showground.

UNENTERED DOGS

We regret that we are UNABLE TO PROVIDE A TENT FOR UNENTERED DOGS at the Show this year. However, you can enter dogs as NOT FOR COMPETITION (at a cost of £10 per dog). This will enable your dog to be benched alongside your entered dogs. Please refer to Not For Competition details above.
Alternatively, unentered dogs may be brought to the Show on the day and admitted as a SPECTATOR DOG (At a cost of £5 per dog). Upon arrival at the Show you will need to complete the necessary Kennel Club Form, giving an undertaking that you will keep your dog under control at all times.

PHOTOGRAPHY & VIDEO RECORDING

The Organisers would like to bring the regulation on photography and filming to the attention of exhibitors, trade stands, press and visitors. It is a condition of all those attending the event that no filming or other form of recording may be taken or made at the venue without express written permission of the organisers. The taking of photographs in the show venue for sale or reward is strictly prohibited except with the written permission of the Organisers. Press accredited photographers are provided with permission to take photographs ONLY for use in newspapers, magazines and internet sites – this is for news purposes only. There is no objection to the general public taking photographs of general views of the show, provided that these are for private use. Specific dogs may be photographed only with the approval of the exhibitor. No photography or filming is permitted in breed judging rings whilst judging is actually taking place. However, judges may allow it to happen at the end of classes or after the Challenge Certificate is awarded. Filming and flash photography is allowed from outside the rings at all times unless the operation of the camera is actually affecting exhibits. However, if a powerful flash unit is used or it is clear that exhibits are being affected, a ring steward or the judge is empowered to stop the person concerned.

MOBILE PHONES

Please show consideration for other exhibitors and ensure that all mobile phones are switched off when judging is in progress in the rings.

RULES & REGULATIONS

Vicious dogs are not eligible and must not be brought to the Show

Exhibitors are held responsible for any damage done by their dog during the exhibition.

- 1 The Show will open at 7.30 a.m. daily.
- 2 Dogs will be received at any time from 7.30 a.m. until 12 noon but it is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
- 3 Breed Judging will start at 10.00 a.m. on Friday and 9.00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday onwards unless otherwise notified or published in the dog press or **with the exhibitors passes**. Exhibitors will be responsible for their dogs being in the ring in time for judging.
- 4 Exhibits may be removed from the show after their judging has been completed. Exhibits may not be removed any earlier unless by written order of the Veterinary Surgeon, Veterinary Practitioner or of the Show management and then only in very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances which must be reported to the Kennel Club. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed at which time dogs must be removed.
- 5 The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of tenting and benching areas is forbidden except as authorised by the Show Management.
- 6 Details of Entry Fees are on page 2. There is no separate benching fee. All entry fees and other charges quoted in this Schedule and on the entry form are inclusive of V.A.T. **ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED ONCE AN ENTRY HAS BEEN MADE. Entries may be made online at www.dog.biz.**
- 7 Prize money under the relevant Stakes classes: **Prize money must be claimed on the day.**
- 8 The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
- 9 Puppies under six calendar months of age **on the first day of the Show** are not eligible for exhibition, i.e. **born after 2nd March 2016**. Please note puppies under 6 months of age are not eligible to enter the showground.
- 10 The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
- 11 **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW: From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information).**
Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and is unbeaten by any other puppy exhibited at the same show. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best of Breed, Best of Group or Best in Show is a puppy it should automatically be awarded Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Similarly, if the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best in Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it should also automatically be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group or Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed and Best in Show respectively.
 - a **Championship Shows Judged on the Group System.** (Definition; Shows judged on Group System - Refer to Regulation 27.b.)
 - 1) **Best Puppy in Breed.** A Best Puppy must be declared in each breed from puppies entered in the Breed Classes.
 - 2) **Best Puppy in Group. From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information)**
Best Puppy in Group and subsequent Puppy Group placings must be selected from:-
 - a) Those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed provided that they are unbeaten by any other puppy.
 - b) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group or on each day provided it is unbeaten by any other puppy.
 - 3) **Best Puppy in Show. From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information).** Best Puppy in Show must be selected from the Best Puppy in Group winners provided they are unbeaten by any other puppy.
 - b **Withdrawal from Competition.** Puppies which become eligible for Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition, other than breed classes and Best Puppy in Breed, prior to the competition for Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show as appropriate, in order to remain unbeaten. A puppy beaten in competition for Best Puppy in Group or Best Puppy in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dog declared Best Puppy in Show, however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Puppies may be withdrawn from Any Variety Classes when judged before Breed Classes.
 - c **Proviso.** For the purpose of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to one breed will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
- 12 **BEST IN SHOW: From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show**

competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information).

The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and is unbeaten by any other dog exhibited at the same Show. Definition of a Category 3 Breed. A breed from time to time designated by the General Committee as requiring particular monitoring by reason of visible condition(s) which may cause health or welfare concerns. The list of designated Category 3 Breeds is kept under regular review.

a. **Shows Judged on the Group System.** (Definition; Shows judged on the Group System includes classes for breeds within more than one Group as defined in Kennel Club Regulation B(A); and requires a judge to declare a Best of each Group after which the exhibits so declared will compete for the award of Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show.)

1) **Best of Breed.** Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared but only from those dogs which have received a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be declared. NOTE: The Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified award relevant to a Category 3 Breed will not be confirmed until the dog has passed an examination by the General and Group Championship Show Veterinary Surgeon.

2) **Best of Group. From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information).**

Best of Group and subsequent Group placings must be selected from:-

a) The Best of Breed winners in each group provided that they are unbeaten winning dogs.

b) The best unbeaten winning dog from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group or on each day.

NOTE: The dog declared Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified from a breed designated by the Kennel Club as a Category 3 Breed is not eligible to compete in the Group competition unless it has passed an examination by the Show's Veterinary Surgeon. If the dog fails to pass the examination it is ineligible to compete in the relevant Group.

3) **Best in Show. From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information).**

Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners provided they are unbeaten. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection of Best in Show.

b. **Withdrawal from other Competition.** Dogs which become eligible for Best of Group and Best in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition other than breed classes and Best of Breed prior to the competition for Best of Group or Best in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A dog beaten in competition for Best of Group or Best in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Dogs may be withdrawn from Any Variety Classes when judged before Breed Classes.

c. **Proviso.** For the purposes of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to a single breed, will not be considered to be beaten dogs.

13 **ADMISSION TO GROUPS:** Exhibits will not be admitted to Group or Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.

14 **HARSH HANDLING:** Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.

15 **PREPARATION OF DOGS:** All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.

16 All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.

17 **DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS.** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.

- When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
- If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
- The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
- Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
- When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
- Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
- Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare. **WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.** Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Limited Rules and Regulations. Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulation to refuse any entry.

- 18 **NOT FOR COMPETITION.** Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.
- 19 **SCHEDULE AMENDMENTS:** No modifications will be made to this schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
- 20 The Show will be held under Kennel Club Limited Rules and Show Regulations. Every exhibitor making an entry or entries at or for this Show shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by the Kennel Club Limited Rules and Show Regulations and by these regulations, and it is on this understanding only that entries are accepted.
- 21 All entries must be made on or before **Monday 4 July 2016**, or made online before **12 noon on Monday 18 July 2016**. Changes to entries can only be made in writing to the Secretary and must be sent on or before postal entries close.
- 22 **If acknowledgement of entries is required, a stamped postcard/envelope with "receipt" written on the reverse side should be enclosed with entries.**
- 23 The Catalogue will contain the owners' name in each breed in alphabetical order with their dogs in numerical order. All dogs will be benched in the catalogue order and owners' dogs of the same breed will be benched together. No decorations, pictures, cards or other notices may be placed over the benches except the Official Prize Cards and exhibitors name and address as per K.C. Regulations. No bench numbers shall be changed from one pen to another and no dog shall be benched on any but its own numbered pen. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES MAY PARTITIONS BETWEEN DOGS BE REMOVED.** Such action weakens the general structure of the benching and is contrary to KC Show Regulations F(1)5c.
WARNING: The benching is provided by the Association in accordance with KC Limited Rules & Show Regulations and whilst the Association has taken all reasonable steps to ensure that the benches provide reasonable security to dogs, owners of dogs using the benching will be solely responsible for any injury or damage suffered to their dog(s) as a result of a defect in the benching or manner of construction thereof. The Association hereby excludes all liability under the Occupiers Liability Act 1957 with respect to any such damage or injury.
- 24 **Exhibitors will receive one pass (not transferable) for each dog entered. If Exhibitor's passes have not been received, or if you have any queries, Higham Press should be contacted direct on 01773 832390.**
- 25 All exhibits must be accompanied. The Committee cannot undertake to accept or despatch unaccompanied dogs. The owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at Kennel Club licensed events must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car parks and approaches.
- 26 All dogs must be removed from their benches within 30 minutes of the completion of Group Judging on the first and second days, and after the Best in Show Judging on the final day.
- 27 All dogs, except Toydogs, must have a benching chain and collar. **NB. TOY CAGES WILL NOT BE PROVIDED.**
- 28 No dog may be removed from its bench, except for the purpose of being prepared for exhibition, judged, exercised or by order of the Veterinary Surgeon or Show Committee. After being prepared, the dog must be replaced on its bench. No dog shall be absent from its bench for the purpose of being exercised at any time for longer than 30 minutes. Dogs may not be present at the ringside, except when their breed is being judged at the same time. **Gangways must be kept clear at all times.** Kennel Club Regulation F(1) 5e applies. The Committee will not be responsible for Exhibitors missing their classes.
- 29 Conversation not allowed in the judging ring. Exhibitors showing dogs are not allowed to hold conversation with the Judges during the competition. **No persons other than Exhibitors (Officials excepted) will be allowed in the ring during the judging of classes or specials.**
- 30 **Change of Judge:** Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling his/her engagement, the Committee reserves the right to appoint a substitute. Exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw from competition, **but no entry fees can be returned.**
- 31 The Committee will be most anxious for the care and safety of the dogs brought for competition, but it must be distinctly understood that the Committee will not be responsible for the loss, detention of or damage whatever, or from any act of omission of themselves, their Officers, agents, servants or others.
- 32 Should any question arise, not provided for by these Regulations or by the Kennel Club Rules, the decision of the Committee shall be final, subject only to appeal to the Kennel Club.
- 33 **DOGS IN VEHICLES: THE COMMITTEE WILL REFUSE ENTRIES FROM ANY EXHIBITOR PROVED, TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE COMMITTEE, TO HAVE LEFT ANY DOG OR DOGS IN A DISTRESSED CONDITION IN ANY MOTOR VEHICLE AT THE SHOW.**
- 34 Every exhibitor shall ensure that whilst the dog is being exhibited, its handler shall display the correct ring number.

NO DOGS SHOULD BE LEFT UNATTENDED AT ANY SHOW FOR VERY LONG PERIODS. THE KENNEL CLUB'S ADVICE TO DOG OWNERS AND BREED SOCIETIES SHOULD BE STUDIED CAREFULLY CONCERNING DOGS AT SHOWS.

DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

(Vide Kennel Club Regulations for Definitions of Classes)

PUPPIES UNDER SIX CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE SHOW ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR EXHIBITION

PUPPIES MUST HAVE BEEN BORN ON OR BEFORE 2ND MARCH 2016

N.B.—The word "dog" includes both sexes

In the following Definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club.

Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members Classes or competing for Members Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society.

In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of **Postal** entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. 27th June 2016.

Wins in Variety Classes do not count for entry in Breed Classes, but when entering for Variety Classes, wins in both Breed and Variety Classes must be counted. A First Prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value.

A dog is not eligible for entry in Variety Classes unless also entered and subsequently exhibited in a Breed Class where such a class is provided for which it is eligible. Exemptions from this Regulation are:

From 1st January 2015, and for a period of two years the Kennel Club Show Regulations which stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class have been suspended.

- (1) A Puppy, unless a class for dogs under twelve months of age for which it is eligible is provided for the breed.
- (2) A dog in Any Variety Veteran Class.
- (3) A dog in Any Variety Champion Class.
- (4) A dog which is withdrawn from exhibition in breed classes as a result of the appointment of an emergency judge.
- (5) A dog in YKC Stakes Classes.
- (6) A dog in KC Good Citizen Scheme Classes
- (7) Exhibits bred by the scheduled breed Judge.

If an exhibitor reports to the Secretary's office **before the judging of a class or classes** that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:

Withdrawal

The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations 9(j) and 20.

Transfer

- (a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct breed colour, sex, weight or height.
- (b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy Class, Puppy Class or Junior Class, which is over age but under 12 calendar months of age, 18 calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy Class, Junior Class or Yearling Class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling Class, to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- (c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- (d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

MINOR PUPPY—For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

PUPPY—For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

JUNIOR—For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

YEARLING—For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty four calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

UNDERGRADUATE—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more First Prizes at Championship Shows, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed. (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

GRADUATE—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

POST GRADUATE—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

LIMIT—For dogs which have not become Show Champions under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club or won seven or more First Prizes in all, at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes, confined to the Breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the Breed.

OPEN—For all dogs of the breeds or varieties for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

VETERAN—For dogs over seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

CHAMPION—For dogs which have been confirmed a Champion, Show Champion or Field Trial Champion. Champion classes may not be scheduled for individual breeds or varieties of breeds.

ANY VARIETY NOT SEPARATELY CLASSIFIED—For breeds of dog for which no separate breed classes are scheduled.

IMPORTED REGISTER—For breeds confined to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by the Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class only, and are ineligible for any other competition whatsoever.

YKC STAKES—All pedigree dogs are eligible to take part provided the dog is registered on the Kennel Club breed register. The dog must be registered a) solely or jointly in the member's name or b) in the name of a member of the family and under these circumstances the dog must be resident at the YKC member's address. No substitute handlers are permitted — the dog must be handled by the YKC member. Members are not permitted to allow another individual to show their dog on their behalf if they are not able to attend the class. Members must be aged 6 - 24 years (for members 6 years and up to, but not including 25th birthday). Please note that membership of the YKC terminates on a member's 25th birthday. Please note that the YKC office will only accept wins from classes that are listed on the YKC website. If a show schedules a YKC class which has not been approved by the YKC Management Team and published on the website, it will not qualify for Crufts. Please note that in order to enter any YKC Crufts qualifying competition you must be a fully paid up member at the time of entry. If you enter a Crufts qualifier and you have not previously paid your membership fee then any award will not count towards qualification for Crufts. Therefore it is important to renew and maintain YKC membership as current if you wish to participate in qualifying Crufts competitions. **Crufts 2017 Qualification Procedure:** The first placed member only in each dog group at the qualifying show will qualify for Crufts. A rosette and prize money is awarded. If the first placed member has already qualified, the Crufts qualification will roll down to the next member (down to 3rd place only).

NOT FOR COMPETITION—Societies may at their discretion, accept Not For Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed. **(Full details of the dog to be given on the entry form and marked N.F.C.)**

GOOD CITIZEN DOG SCHEME—For dogs which have achieved their Good Citizen Dog Scheme Bronze Award Certificate or above. Certificates should be available at the show for inspection if requested.

REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F(B)

- 1 These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A42.
 - (a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.
 - (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A42.
- 2 (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the Show.
 - (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
- 3 No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:
 - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee.
 - (b) The removal of dewclaws of any breed.
 - (c) Operations to prevent breeding, provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
- 4 The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
- 5 An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
- 6 Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

The attention of exhibitors is drawn to the fact that any advertisement for a coat preparation or shampoo or similar in either Schedule or Catalogue does not imply that the use of such preparation may not contravene Kennel Club Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition-F. This also applies to any coat preparation or shampoo or similar on sale at The City of Birmingham Dog Show. The attention of exhibitors is directed to the declaration they are required to sign on the Entry form.

The Order of Judging is not published in this schedule but will be sent out with exhibitor's passes.

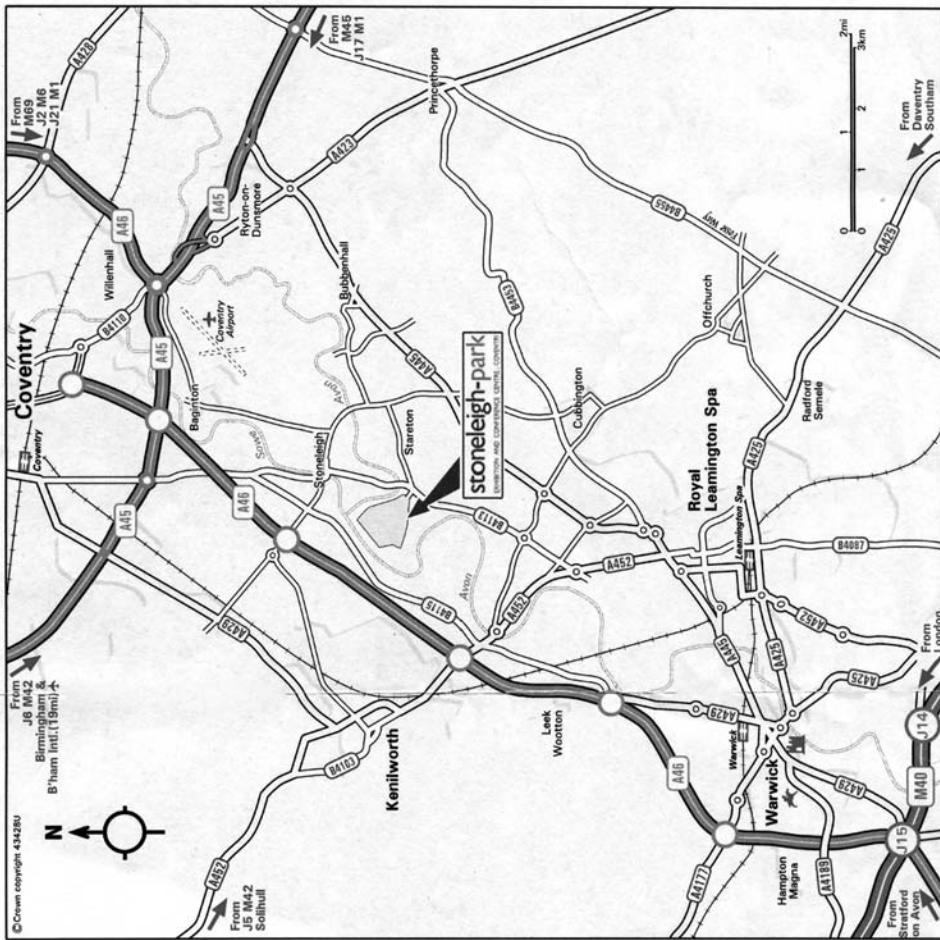

- From London and M40 Leave the M40 at junction 15 and join the A46 dual carriageway towards Coventry.
- Follow the signs for National Agricultural Centre or NAC Stoneleigh Park until you pick up the signs for Stoneleigh Park. These signs will direct you to Stoneleigh Park Main Entrance on the B4113.
- From the M6 or M69 Leave the M6 motorway at junction 2 and join the A46 towards Warwick. Or, at the conclusion of the M69, continue onto the A46 towards Warwick and the M40.
- Follow the signs for National Agricultural Centre or NAC Stoneleigh Park until you pick up the signs for Stoneleigh Park. These signs will direct you to Stoneleigh Park Main Entrance on the B4113.
- From the Northbound M4, Leave the M4 at junction 17, to join the M45 towards Coventry. Stay on the M45 until you pick up signs for A6 Coventry (not A6 Daventry). Follow the A45 until you pick up signs for A46 Warwick.
- Follow the signs for National Agricultural Centre or NAC Stoneleigh Park until you pick up the signs for Stoneleigh Park. These signs will direct you to Stoneleigh Park Main Entrance on the B4113.
- By Train From London to Coventry: Services every half hour (daytime Mon-Fri) in both directions between London Euston and Coventry. Scheduled journey times may vary but are generally less than 1 hour 15 minutes.
- From London to Warwick Parkway: Services every half hour (daytime Mon-Fri) in both directions between London Marylebone and Warwick Parkway.
